



Notice to DP World Fremantle customers – Import storage rates

Customers are advised that effective from **1st September 2010**, Import storage rates for laden and empty containers held at Fremantle Terminal will be amended to reflect the increase in terminal occupancy costs, the ongoing need to reduce dwell times and to improve efficiency for all concerned. Containers are available free of storage charges for a period of three working days.

Expiry of the free storage period will see import containers remaining in the Terminal subject to the following rates effective from 1st September 2010:

† If a reefer container is held at the Terminal beyond the free storage period, reefer service charges will apply in addition to the daily storage charges.

†† The yard handling fee is a single charge, applicable to all containers in the Terminal beyond the free period.

††† The Hazardous container fees will be applied on a daily basis in addition to import storage charges detailed above.

Our preferred payment method is by ComPay. We are not, however, requiring you to use ComPay in order to use our import storage service. You remain free to use any payment method other than cheque (ie EFT direct to DP World Fremantle).

All customers are reminded that containers will not be released until all storage owing has been paid.
